Priority 2 - Social Development Across Borders

SO 2.1: Improving equal access to inclusive and quality services in education, training and lifelong learning through developing accessible infrastructure, including by fostering resilience for distance and on-line education and training;

SO 2.2: Ensuring equal access to health care and fostering resilience of health systems, including primary care, and promoting the transition from institutional to family-based and community-based care.

This call allows for participation of **partners registered outside the Programme area** only if the following conditions are met cumulatively:

- The project addresses Priority 2, **Specific Objective 2.1**;
- The activities to be performed by the partner located outside the programme area are implemented directly or with the support of their **offices/ branches in the Programme area** or for the benefit of the Programme area.

INTERREG ROMÂNIA-UCRAINA

RO-UA

The present call addresses only **regular projects**, with an investment component of minimum 500,000 EUR per project.

No limitations are set for an organization to participate in several projects submitted under the present call for proposals.

1,000,000 - 1,400,000 EURO (regardless of the specific objective)

Priorities and specific objectives:

- Enhancing protection and preservation of nature, biodiversity, and green infrastructure, including in urban areas, and reducing all forms of pollution.

2. Cooperation for a more social and cohesive PA between Romania and Hungary

3. A more sustainable, community-based, and effective cross-border cooperation

- Build up mutual trust, in particular by encouraging people-to-people actions.

LIFE-2023-SAP-CLIMA-CCM - Climate Change Mitigation

Areas of intervention

- Actions to reduce greenhouse gas emissions in the sectors not covered by the EU Emissions Trading System⁶, including the reduction of use of fluorinated greenhouse gases and ozone-depleting substances
- Actions which enhance the functioning of the existing EU Emissions Trading System and which have an impact on energy and greenhouse gas intensive industrial production
- Increase the generation and use of renewable energy and improvement of energy efficiency

LIFE-2023-SAP-CLIMA-CCA - Climate Change Adaptation

Areas of intervention

- Adaptation policy development, and adaptation strategies and plans
- Adapting cities and regions to climate change
- Climate-proofing and resilience of infrastructure and buildings
- Adaptation solutions for farmers, forest managers, Natura 2000 managers and other land managers
- Financial instruments, innovative solutions and public private collaboration on insurance and loss data

Areas of intervention

- Awareness-raising activities addressing adaptation and mitigation needs
- Greenhouse gas emission monitoring and reporting

- Development and implementation of greenhouse gas accounting and climate change mitigation in the land use sector
- Climate policy monitoring, assessment and ex-post evaluation

LIFE-2023-CET-LOCAL

Proposals should address one or both of the following areas/aspects:

1. Actions should provide technical support to LRAs (Local and regional authorities) and build their capacities to deliver ambitious short and medium-term CET plans and strategies for 2030.
2. Actions should aim at creating/reinforcing appropriate organisational structures to support and coordinate the implementation and monitoring of integrated CET (clean energy transition) plans and strategies within and beyond the administrations.

LIFE-2023-CET-POLICY

Actions under this topic are expected to:

- Support the monitoring and evaluation of policy implementation.
- Develop and apply methodologies to more accurately measure, calculate and account for contributions made under the specific policy measures and programmes. etc.

LIFE-2023-CET-EPREL

The proposed action should cover one or more of the following areas:

1. Systematically checking and improving EPREL data, and reporting issues identified, including via the EPREL's (European Product Registry for Energy Labelling) missing or erroneous model reporting features.
2. Promoting further EPREL's use as well as its innovative utilisation for new applications.
3. Crowd-sourced compliance control of the publicly available data, with input from consumers and economic operators, to boost compliance, completeness and reliability of the data.

Proposals must be submitted by at least 3 applicants from 3 different eligible countries.

Priority 1 - e-Justice

Priority given to projects aiming at joining or enhancing existing or on-going e-Justice projects:

Projects facilitating electronic cross-border interaction and communication between judicial authorities, as well as with citizens, businesses and practitioners in judicial proceedings

Priority given to the development of concrete cases on the use of artificial intelligence and distributed ledger technology in the justice area

Activities that can be funded:

- analytical, conceptual, design and elaboration work, IT software development, quality assurance and related auxiliary measures necessary for the establishment of new IT systems, as well as the expansion and adaptation of existing national and transnational solutions towards addressing the objectives of the call.

Priority 2 - Victims' rights and procedural rights

Activities that can be funded:

- mutual learning, exchange of good practices, development of working and learning methods which may be transferable to other participating countries;
- capacity building for professionals, including training in victim-sensitive communication;
- analytical activities, such as data collection and creation of data bases, surveys, research etc.

Project duration: 12-24 months
